YOUR RESPONSIBILITY:

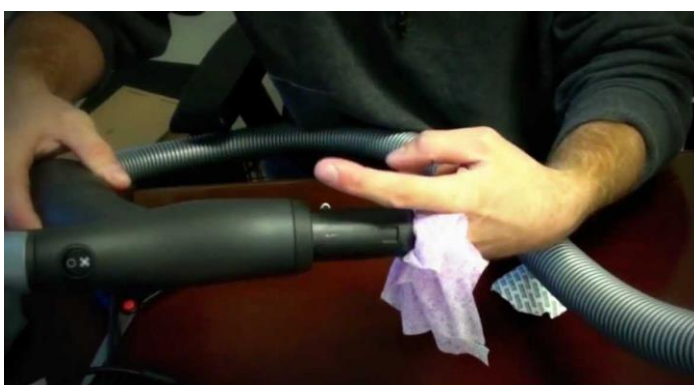

Vacuum Cleaner Stopped Working?

The most common problems would be one of the following:

- 1) Hose has been blocked by big objects: you will need to check the hose. If the attachment hose has no suction, either it or the hose suction port is clogged. Try sucking out the clog with a strong vacuum. If that doesn't work, use the bent hanger technique to remove the clog.



- 2) The Vacuum cleaners bags are full: You will need to open the vacuum cleaner and check the bag inside, if it is too full, then you will need to replace it. You can purchase the vacuum cleaners bag at any big super market, please note down the make of the vacuum cleaner. You can search the manual on YouTube or google.



IMPORTANT NOTES

Please do not use the Vacuum cleaners without bags (Unless they are bagless Vacuum Cleaners), if the vacuum cleaners has been damaged i.e motor has been burned out, as result of incorrect usage, you will be responsible for replacement cost.

Most of our vacuum cleaners are Henry as shown in the photo above, the bags are available to purchase in all supermarkets.

If you still have problems after you checked the hose and replaced the bags, please report it on our APP. Please keep receipts of the bags if case if you are eligible for reimbursement.
